## *Reflections From the Pastor*

*“The liturgy is the summit toward which the activity”  
of the Church is directed...it is the font from which  
all her power flows.”*

**Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy #10**

Vatican II did not simply happen in a vacuum. But rather it was a logical response to a movement to renew the sacred liturgy that began even prior to the First Vatican Council (1870). It was a movement that in its origins owed much to the Benedictines of Germany and later France.

In 1903 Pope St. Pius X issued a remarkable document (*motu proprio*) on sacred music in the liturgy, Tra le Sollecitudini, that embraced the new liturgical movement within the Church. In his document one hears the pope talking about the *active participation* of the assembly in the liturgy. For us, from our perspective it may be somewhat difficult to appreciate the radical nature of what Pius was saying. In principle all of the Baptized are called to *full and active participation* in the sacred liturgy.

Pius X saw that to bring this about it was necessary to make what I am sure appeared to many as radical changes in the role of music in the Latin Mass. What he did was to *restore* Gregorian chant to its rightful place in Catholic worship. The reason was that the music was simple and uncomplicated and, therefore, enabled the full and active participation of the assembly in the Mass. I am sure that many a choir director and choir was horrified by these changes initiated by the “peasant pope” from Sardinia.

Later Pope Pius XII would develop further the thinking of Pius X. Pius XII was to issue three encyclicals: Mystici Corporis (Mystical Body of Christ) 1943, Divino Afflante Spiritu (Sacred Scripture) 1945, and Mediator Dei 1947, that would have a major impact on the liturgical movement and lay the foundation for what was to take place at the Second Vatican Council.

If one considers the themes treated in these encyclicals, one comes to appreciate more deeply the richness of Catholic liturgy and tradition, as well as its biblical roots. Mystici Corporis was to come from a reflection on the horrors of what was taking place in Europe (World War II) – a loss of a sense of our common humanity (the *mystical body of Christ*). Pope John Paul II would later in his social encyclicals talk of the need for a greater sense of solidarity. Violence often comes from a loss of a sense of our common humanity. Liturgy which is by nature a communal activity reminds us of the need not only to pray together but also to work together to make God’s kingdom a reality in the world.

The encyclical on Sacred Scripture, Divino Afflante Spiritu, completely changed how Catholic scholars approached the study of Sacred Scripture. The modern studies of archeology and anthropology, plus the scientific approach to historical studies, were embraced by the Church, leading to new and deeper insights into the Word of the Lord. With these developments came a recognized need to make changes in the liturgy to enable all Catholics to know and appreciate God’s Word. One would come to see the fruit of this encyclical in the publishing of the Lectionary after Vatican II. With the Lectionary Scripture was restored to a prominent place in the liturgy, enabling Catholics to come to a new understanding of the relationship between *Word* and *Sacrament*. One very positive outcomes of the reform of the Liturgy of the Word in the Mass is the restoration of the Hebrew Scriptures (Old Testament) to their rightful place in Catholic prayer and theology. It is worth noting that one of the motivating factors for the changes in the wording of the prayers at Mass in the new Missal is to make the wording more Scriptural - to connect the words of our prayers with their origin in Scripture, both the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures.



### LISTENING TO GOD

Familiarity, in the case of the Lord's Prayer, probably hasn't bred contempt in most of us, but it certainly can breed a kind of inertia. The words we speak in prayer run the same risks as all our other human words: they can be spoken hastily, thoughtlessly, carelessly. In a manner parallel to the words we say in the Lord's Prayer—"forgive us as we forgive others"—today might be the day to invite God to "listen to us as well as we listen to you." Today might be the day to listen to the Lord's Prayer with newly attentive ears.

Let us learn from the example of Luke's Jesus, who would not instruct others how to pray until he himself had been a man of prayer. Moreover, listen carefully to the follow-up Jesus gives for the prayer itself. In our quick-fix society we must heed the call to persistence; in a world that puts glib explanations on difficult situations we must continue to seek and knock; in our all-too-humanness, we must be open to the patience, grace, and wisdom of the will of God. Do we want the Lord to listen to our voice? Maybe we can start by listening to God's.

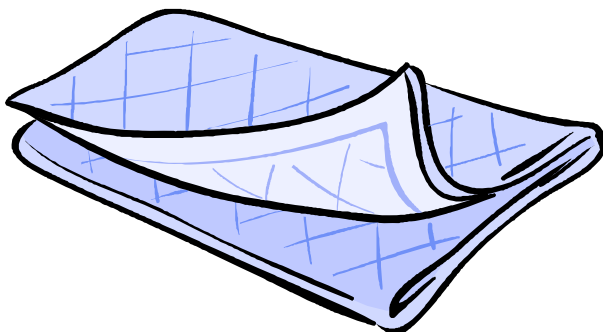

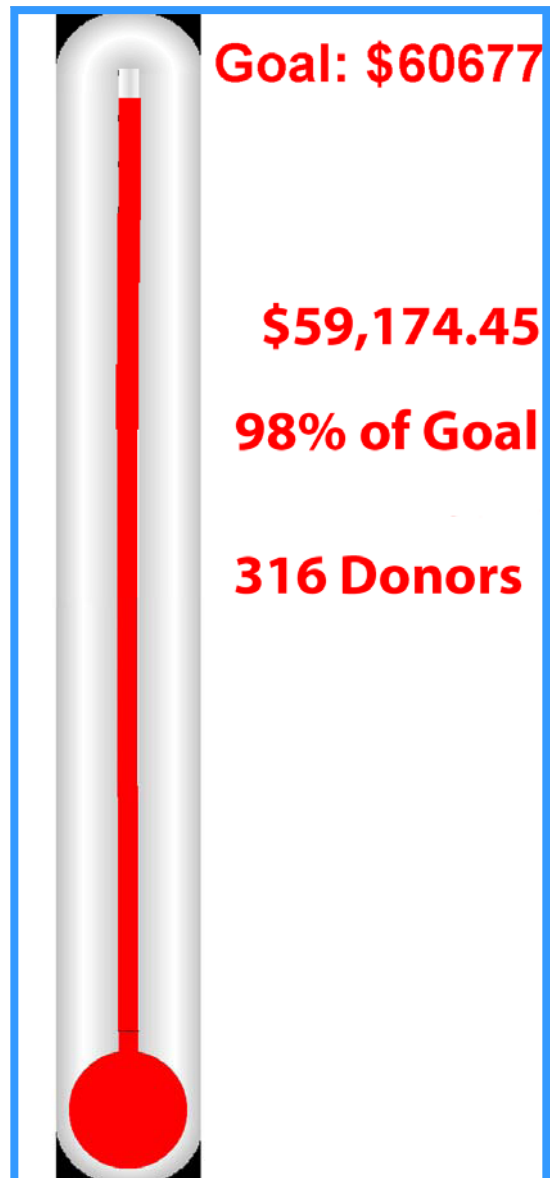

Estando en recuperación le dieron a leer los Evangelios y la vida de los santos y, como él siempre había soñado con cosas mayores, encontró en la vida de los santos algo que realmente valía la pena y renunció a su ambición militar para servir a Dios. A partir de ahí inició una experiencia de conversión que lo llevó a entregarse a Dios por completo y a ayudar a otras personas a que encontraran a Dios en todo. Siendo adulto se preparó en las ciencias humanas y con otros compañeros, entre ellos San Francisco Xavier, fundó la Compañía de Jesús; conocidos actualmente como los Jesuitas.

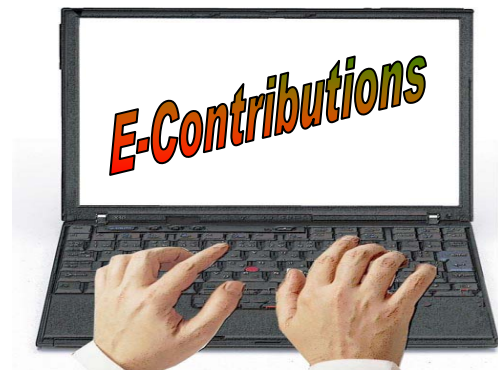

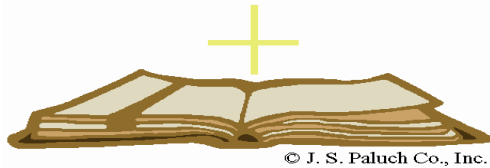
